



Master's Degree in Speech Language Pathology

Nova Southeastern University (NSU)

TTI's Speech Language Pathology program in partnership with NOVA Southeastern University (NSU) is a 100% online master's degree. For those students who know at the undergraduate level that they would like to apply to this program, a TTI advisor will guide you to complete your bachelor's degree prior to acceptance into the graduate program. When planning the undergraduate degree, all prerequisite courses are included. All speech prerequisite courses are taken through Utah State University and takes the average student 3 semesters (or one year) to complete.

Program Design

- 100% online
- Flexible schedule designed around the Yomim Tovim.
- Program will be completed in 8 semesters. Each semester is 15 weeks.

Fast Facts

- Program beginning May 2021 (tentative.)
- This program is available for US residents outside of Brooklyn, Lakewood and Monsey, but living in the United States.
- The total cost of the program is approximately \$68,500.

Program Prerequisites

- 7 prerequisite online speech courses (through Utah State University) will cost \$8,000 on top of the cost of a regular bachelor's degree.

Additional Program Requirements

- Minimum GPA of 3.2 required

Other Information

Men and Canadian students are not eligible for this program. Men can complete prerequisites for NOVA and apply to NOVA's general program or any other speech program of their choice. If they are planning to apply to programs other than NOVA, IT IS THEIR RESPONSIBILITY TO RESEARCH THE PROGRAM AND ITS PRE-REQUISITES, and a TTI advisor can direct them to the Utah courses that correspond to their needs. Canadian women can apply to NOVA only if they will be residing in the US at the time of application and for the duration of the program.
