A psychology degree is an excellent way to prepare for a wide range of professions. Learning to analyze data, communicate complex information and the ability to understand human behavior are sought after skills by employers. A degree in psychology enables a student to enter a variety of graduate programs as well as enter the work force.

Program Design

Once enrolled, an academic advisor will conduct a 1st appointment meeting with the student to design their personalized degree plan leading to the completion of 120 credits for a bachelor's degree. Should the student have previous credits, the advisor will take that into consideration as well. Students earn 33 credits in psychology, 27 credits in History, Humanities, Math, Natural Sciences, and Written English, and another 60 credits in almost any topic a student would like to pursue. The majority of credits can be earned by taking proficiency exams in General Studies and Limudei Kodesh including, but not limited to, Jewish Subject Exams (JSE's) and UExcel exams. Online courses are also available, depending on the student's interests and prerequisite needs for graduate study.

- Most students complete this degree within one year or less, as it is an entirely self-paced degree.
- Program Cost: \$10,700
- Financial aid is available for eligible students. An eligible NY resident can receive approximately \$4,000, while an eligible non-NY resident can receive \$1,500.
