Associates in Business/Accounting – Eastwick College

- **Accounting classes will be in class, held face-to-face** on Sunday (10am-6pm) and Tuesday evenings (6pm-10pm.)
- Fill in the rest of the Associate degree with core general education requirements. Your experienced academic advisor will guide you through this process.

- Program length: 10 months.

Bachelor's Degree in Liberal Studies – Excelsior College

- Transfer from Eastwick College to Excelsior College to complete your Bachelor's Degree.
- Courses include 24 business and 24 accounting credits as required for a NJ CPA license.
- This part of the program is self-study with guidance from a TTI advisor who will work with you step by step.
- Includes the cornerstone and capstone at Excelsior.
- Apply seminary credits!
- Program length: 8 months

Program Cost

Lowest possible cost for students with incoming seminary credits and financial aid: \$10,100

To complete 150 credits (with 30 seminary credits, no financial aid): \$24,280

To complete 150 credits (without 30 seminary credits, and no financial aid): \$25,780
