You will learn about textiles and furniture, and computer design software, including AutoCAD and SketchUp Pro. Students will receive 222 hours of face-to-face instruction by licensed teachers. The curriculum focuses on residential projects, and will cover the basic drawing and drafting skills needed. You'll also learn subjects like design theory, understanding building and construction materials, and business development.

At the end of this intensive course, students will develop their own professional portfolio to showcase their design and technical skills through assigned projects. You'll also be trained to network, and interact professionally with clients and employers. By the time you're through, you'll be able to enter the workforce with poise and confidence, ready to work your magic on interiors everywhere.
