Bachelor of Science in Business

A business degree provides students with a wide range of knowledge that would prepare them for many aspects of the workforce. Students have the choice to concentrate in several areas, among them accounting, finance, general business, management of human resources, marketing, and logistics management.

These business programs focus on high-growth industries with a demand for educated workers.

Program Design

Once enrolled, a knowledgeable academic advisor will conduct an initial meeting with the student to design a personalized degree plan leading to the completion of 120 credits for a bachelor's degree (or 150 credits for New York or New Jersey CPA licensure in accounting). Should the student have previous credits, the advisor will take that into consideration as well. Students earn 60 credits in History, Humanities, Math, Natural Sciences, Social Sciences, and Written English, and another 60 credits in Business and elective courses. The majority of credits can be earned by taking proficiency exams in Business, Accounting and other General Studies. If any additional credits are needed, they can be earned through Jewish Subject Exams (JSE). Online courses are also available, to complete more specialized business requirements.

Students can choose to earn one of the following concentrations:

- Bachelor of Science in Business (General Business)
- Bachelor of Science in Business (Accounting)
- Bachelor of Science in Business (Finance)
- Bachelor of Science in Business (Management of Human Resources)
- Bachelor of Science in Business (Marketing)
- Bachelor of Science in Business (Logistic Management)

- Open enrollment. Start anytime.
- Self-paced.
- Most students complete this degree in about 2 years.

- The cost of this program for the general business degree is approximately \$11,000. For a more specified concentration the fee can increase up to \$14,500-\$18,000.
